Nominating Committee Meets In January

Governor Tom Foltz has appointed Past Governor Steve Krut to serve as the chairman for the Nominating Committee to help select a slate of officers for the Board of Directors. The first meeting of the Nominating Committee will be held on Thurs., January 14, at 6 p.m.

The Committee will be composed of all current elected officers, five past governors and members-at-large. A list of available offices will be posted in the Social Quarters. After the first meeting of the Committee, nomination forms for each office will be available in the Lodge. The Committee will have two additional meetings before tendering its recommended slate of candidates at the Lodge meeting in March. The actual election will be held at the first Lodge meeting in April and elected officers shall take office on May 1, most for a one-year term. Trustees are also elected to one, two and three-year terms.

Interclub Shuffleboard Tournament

A shuffleboard tournament will be hosted by the Sports Committee on Sunday, February 28, starting at 1 p.m. in our Lodge.
